Situated in Peter Lougheed Provincial Park, overlooking Lower Kananaskis Lake, William Watson Lodge provides yearround, barrier-free, wilderness lodging for persons with disabilities, Alberta seniors and their families.



Operated by Alberta Parks, the lodge supports connecting people of all abilities to recreational opportunities in nature.

Named after William Watson, an Albertan who worked to improve the social and environmental conditions for persons with disabilities, the lodge and surroundings include: 22 accessible cabins, 10 full service campsites, 1 comfort camping site, a covered group firepit, accessible playground, accessible picnic sites and over 20 km of accessible trails.

Directions

Located about 150 km from Calgary.

Turn south onto highway 40 off highway 1. After 56 km, turn right off highway 40 onto the Kananaskis Lakes Trail.

Watch for signs for the William Watson Lodge turnoff.

Booking Priorities

Verification of eligibility is required for all guests at check-in.

Albertans with Disabilities

- Non-ambulatory
- Legally blind
- · Profoundly deaf
- Dependently cognitively disabled
- Semi ambulatory

Guests may reserve **120 days** in advance of the scheduled arrival date.

Alberta Seniors and Outof-Province Persons with Disabilities

- Albertan seniors age 65 and over
- Out of province persons with disabilities

Guests may reserve **60 days** in advance of the scheduled arrival date.

Cabin Seasons

All cabin reservations require a minimum stay of 2 nights.

Summer: June 1 - September 30

Guests may make 1 reservation for a maximum stay of 7 nights.

Winter: October 1 - May 31

Guests may make 2 reservations for a combined stay of 7 nights.

Main Lodge

Small Group: 10–20 people (half day or full day) Large Group: 21–100 people (half day or full day)

Reservations required for day use groups larger than 9 people. One half of the group must be Albertans with disabilities and/or Albertan seniors.


